On Monday, November 22, 2021 I, Officer [REDACTED], was assigned to the Uniform Division of the Fall River Police Department, sector 8. At approximately 5:27pm, I was dispatched to 130 Lowell Street, apartment 1W, for a reported past domestic. Officer [REDACTED], sector 7, responded as well.

Upon arrival to the aforementioned address, I encountered a female who identified herself as [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]/1989). Ms. [REDACTED] began explaining to me that she was assaulted, on Saturday November 20, 2021, by her boyfriend of approximately 2 years, Anthony Harden (DOB: [REDACTED]/1991). Ms. [REDACTED] began describing that her and Mr. Harden have a tumultuous relationship and that she has been habitually abused by Mr. Harden, but has never filed a report. I was then informed by Ms. [REDACTED] that on Saturday she was assaulted at Mr. Harden's 1st floor apartment, located at 120 Melville Street. Ms. [REDACTED] then began explaining that on the night of the incident her and Mr. Harden had gotten into an argument over cell phone numbers she had blocked in her contacts. She continued stating that during this argument Mr. Harden became increasingly agitated and then physically assaulted her. When providing details of the alleged assault Ms. [REDACTED] stated Mr. Harden had struck her across the side of her face with what she described as a whip like stick, that Mr. Harden had in his bedroom. Ms. [REDACTED] continued stating that Mr. Harden had then pinned her to the bed and had gotten on top of her, grabbing her by the arms, collar bone and neck areas. Ms. [REDACTED] then made marks on both sides of her face apparent, which showed scratch like injuries consistent with the assault she described. Ms. [REDACTED] also showed me bruises on the bicep area of both arms where she stated Mr. Harden had grabbed her when he pinned her down. When Mr. Harden was pinning Ms. [REDACTED] down she stated she had kicked him off of her. Once Ms. [REDACTED] was able to stand up she stated she pushed Mr. Harden away and ran out of the apartment.

Ms. [REDACTED] then stated that she had later returned to 120 Melville Street to retrieve items she had left behind when she initially fled. Ms. [REDACTED] stated she had left her cell phone, wallet, and shoes. Ms. [REDACTED] continued stating that when she received her phone from Mr. Harden he still appeared agitated. She stated when she was given her cell phone she felt a wet substance on it and accused Mr. Harden of destroying the phone. Ms. [REDACTED] also accused Mr. Harden of drawing on the back of her cell phone case. Ms. [REDACTED] then showed me the case and cell phone. I observed there to be a green paint like substance on the cell phone case. I also observed the phone screen of Ms. [REDACTED]'s phone unable to turn on. It should be noted that photographs of Ms. [REDACTED]'s injuries and of her cell phone case were taken and are in the possession of the Massachusetts State Police.

While speaking with Ms. [REDACTED] she also began informing me that she had been receiving a high amount of unwanted phone calls from Mr. Harden. She stated Mr. Harden not only calls her phone, but also calls her sons phone and her sister's, [REDACTED] (DOB: [REDACTED]). Both Ms. [REDACTED] and [REDACTED] then showed me the call logs of the phone, showing instances where Mr. Harden had called the phone 37 times within a 10 minute span and when Mr. Harden had called the sons cell phone 76 times.

After receiving this information, I presented and explained Ms. [REDACTED] with her rights per the Fall River Police Department Domestic Violence Victim's Rights Form. Ms. [REDACTED] signed this form stating she understood her rights. Ms. [REDACTED] stated at that time that she did not wish to obtain a restraining order. Officer [REDACTED] and I then left 130 Lowell Street to go to 120 Melville Street to affect the arrest of Mr. Harden, based on the above facts and circumstance. For further information please refer to the reports and investigation conducted by the Massachusetts State Police.
